



Learning Safely - Corona Virus Safety Measures

When you arrive onsite at Holy Cross College and University Centre for the first time you should be aware that new safety measures have been implemented upon government advice to help reduce and prevent the threat of the Corona Virus. These measures are a necessity to help ensure the safety of everyone.

Most safety measures are temporary and will be in place for as long as the government advises. Please note that these measures will change and evolve as the college returns closer to full capacity and we appreciate your flexibility in this matter.

Do's & Don'ts

- **Do** be vigilant on public transport and wear a face covering
- **Do** wear your face covering in corridors and communal areas
- **Do** use a plastic bag to store your face covering when on site for class
- **Do** practice good hygiene whilst on site and be aware of the 'Catch it, Bin it, Kill it' approach to sneezing.
- **Do not** attend University if you feel unwell, have a high temperature, a persistent cough or have lost your sense of taste or sense of smell.
- **Do** use the main entrance to the site on Manchester Road to access the college or follow directions by members of staff for special events
- **Do not** forget to bring your college identity badge when you attend University, new students will be issued one of these at enrolment.
- **Do** use the foot operated hand sanitisers installed at the main reception and others around the whole college site when entering. Look out for other types of sanitisers installed around buildings at entrances and exits.
- **Do not** walk through the college buildings without having sanitised your hands



- **Do** stick to the one-way systems which are now in place, this includes the majority of staircases
Do not take short cuts even if it is for a short distance. You may have to walk a little further but please remember why these measures have been implemented



- **Do** maintain a 2m distance with others whilst you are on the college site and take notice of the social distancing graphics on college floors.
- **Do not** wander around the college unnecessarily and please **do not** stand waiting in hatched areas.



- **Do** be aware access to certain areas of the college at certain times will remain restricted or locked off this may include social areas, Library and IT areas.
Do not enter or attempt to enter locked or restricted areas
- **Do** notice toilet cubicles and urinals have been taped or locked off to ensure social distancing. There is a strict maximum of two persons in all toilet block facilities and queuing outside will be necessary to facilitate this.
Do wash your hands regularly and thoroughly.
Do not enter toilets in pairs, do not remove tape or unlock locked toilets
- **Do** take note - tables, desks, chairs etc. may not be repositioned in rooms for classes but lecturers will ensure social distancing in classrooms as class sizes will be reduced in number.
Do not move tables and chairs
- **Do** bring your own stationery, notebook and pens
Do not expect your lecturer to provide such items
